Honoring Leadership and Achievement.

The Oklahoma Foundation Quarter Horse Registry is committed to providing leadership and scholarship opportunities to enable our youth to further excel in their future careers and competition.

The Oklahoma Foundation Quarter Horse Registry will award two scholarships each year. Winners of the OKFQHR Ann Tamm Memorial scholarships will be decided by a committee appointed by the OKFQHR board and will be announced at the banquet in February each year.

To apply, please complete an application by typing or printing neatly in blue or black ink. Determination for a scholarship is based on academic achievement, career plans, OKFQHyR involvement, other activities and references. If selected as a scholarship recipient, portions of your essay may be used in print and internet promotion.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENT

An application must be postmarked for consideration by January 31. To apply for an Oklahoma Foundation Quarter Horse Registry scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements.

1. An applicant must be a current OKFQHR and FQHR member in good standing. Applicant must have participated in the youth program for at least two full years and turned in a LEAP form for those years and current year or final year in the youth division. An applicant must also be a senior in high school or pursuing an undergraduate degree in a two- or four- year- institution, trade or technical school. In addition, previous recipients of OKFQHR scholarships are not eligible to reapply for scholarships.
2. All applicants must submit an essay. Essays must meet the following criteria.
 - Essays should not exceed two pages double spaced.
 - All essays must be typed in 12 pt. Arial font.
 - Applicants must include a coversheet with applicants name.

ESSAY TOPIC

Detail Your involvement with OKFQHR. Describe how your experience will benefit the pursuit of your college and career goals as well as your future plans.

3. Applicants must submit a transcript or recent grade report. Applicants cumulative grade point average must be shown. If applicants school follows a grade scale other than a 4.0 scale, please give an explanation of the procedure.
4. Applicants must submit two letters of reference.
 - (1) Current OKFQHR member
 - (1) Personal or Professional (Teacher, Coach, Trainer, etc.)
 1. Letters of reference states how he or she knows the member and for how long.
 2. References may not be written by a parent, legal guardian or a relative.
 3. The reference must have knowledge of the member's activities and must validate them in the recommendation.
 4. All letters of reference must be type written and may not exceed one page.
5. Please include a 3" X 5" head and shoulders photo with your application. If selected, this photo will be used for promotion purposes and will be published in the OKFQHR Newsletter, facebook page and website.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Scholarship funding will be issued directly to the college or university on a semester by semester basis. Under no circumstances will the funding be sent to recipient.

Recipient must provide OKFQHR Youth Department with the following information for the release of funds:

- School Name
- School Financial Aid office address
- Contact
- Contact's phone number
- Funds may be used for tuition, books, academic fees and board.
- If the recipient chooses to postpone their education, they must contact OKFQHR Youth Director. If the OKFQHR Youth Director is not contacted within one year of receiving the scholarship, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- Recipients of scholarship are eligible until the age of 21
