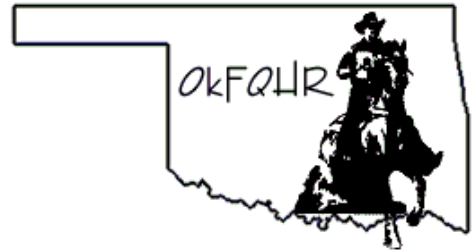

4. Applicant must be current High School Senior or College student.

6. Only one (1) scholarship may be received.
7. Scholarship may be used for college, Vo-Tech or trade school.
8. LEAP form must be completed for prior year. (LEAP form are posted on web site)
