2006 Super Stakes

If you have a 2006 foal that you plan to show in the 2006 Super Stakes you need to start the foal registration process ASAP.

All foals must be registered with both the AQHA and the FQHR.

The AQHA does provide online foal registration which can significantly reduce the registration time on their part.

The process takes longer with the FQHR due to the limited size of their staff. Please help out the FQHR staff by registering your foals as soon as possible so that they are not inundated with paperwork at the last minute.

Cowboy Church Services will be held at 8am on Sunday.

A note from your officers and show committee members:

What do you need to have IN HAND when you come to the office?

- Current NEGATIVE Coggins paperwork (original yellow copy—this is OK state law)
- Membership cards (FQHR, OkFQHR, & Amateur)
- Your FQHR Horse Registration Papers (to check ownership and double check registration numbers)
- Checkbook (you must either pay when you check in or leave an open check in the office)

Please have these things with you when you come to the office to expedite your check in! If you do not provide this information to the show staff, you will not be allowed to show.

Stalls—please read this, very important!

Please DO NOT put your horse in a stall without paying for it! You may not realize it, but the club is charged for every single stall used—if you don't pay the stall fee, you are only cheating your own club (and driving up the costs of putting on a show).

You also MUST put down shavings every time you use a stall. Once again, this isn't an OkFQHR requirement, but a requirement of the Expo Center, with whom your club has signed a contract that states this as one of the requirements for use of the facility. If you want to be able to keep utilizing this facility for our shows, we have to play by the rules. We apologize for the costs involved, but we are only passing on what the Expo Center charges us, and we have no control over what the Expo Center charges.

In order to ensure the safety of our exhibitors and guests, please do not leave your horses unattended in or around the arena or warm-up area.

Laminated back numbers are still available from our youth group.

For only \$10, you will receive two laminated back numbers of your choice (range: 1-999) that you can use throughout the entire show season. Numbers are assigned per horse and rider/handler combination; therefore a separate number will need to be purchased for each combination. If the horse is five years old and younger, the number will be printed on yellow paper as specified in the FQHR Rule Book.

These numbers are valid for all OkFQHR shows only (not the Round-Up and Review). Numbers are good for one show season only. If you purchased a number last year, you must purchase it again this year.

If you want your number to be delivered to the June show, requests must be made no later than June 6.
