The OkFQHR 2005 General Membership Meeting will be held after the Costume Class on Oct. 15th. Dinner will be a spaghetti dinner with garlic bread, salad, tea, and peach cobbler with ice cream—free to OkFQHR members and only \$5.00 to non-members.

The meeting will center around the divisions (youth, novice, amateur, open) of the classes we offer.

We want to discuss what is involved in offering mostly sanctioned classes and whether the membership as a whole wants to go that way.

We also want to discuss the classes we will offer in 2006.

We took care of officer elections at this meeting last year, and if time allows, we will do that again this year.

If you would be willing to be on the board or the show committee please come and voice your desire.

The Youth Group will be having a Fundraiser Barrel Class on October 16th. The entry fee will be \$10 at the gate. Negative Coggins papers will be required on all live horses without numbers. No office activity is required. This class is open to any one and any mount. You can even ride a stick horse if you want! Donated items will be awarded to the fastest three rides.

Don't forget to check out the club website for year end award standings, online entry forms, the club message board, messages from the club's officers and board members, stallion auction information, and information on club activities!

You can pre-enter online and save \$5 off of your office fee, as well as a lot of time waiting in the office.

**A note from your officers and show committee members:****What do you need to have IN HAND when you come to the office?**

- Current NEGATIVE Coggins paperwork (original yellow copy—this is OK state law)
- Membership cards (Otherwise, how does the office staff know you're a current member?)
- Your FQHR Horse Registration Papers (to check ownership and double check registration numbers)
- Checkbook (you must either pay when you check in or leave an open check in the office)

Please have these things with you when you come to the office to expedite your check in!

**Stalls—please read this, very important!**

Please DO NOT put your horse in a stall without paying for it! You may not realize it, but the club is charged for every single stall used—if you don't pay the stall fee, you are only cheating your own club (and driving up the costs of putting on a show).

You also MUST put down shavings every time you use a stall. Once again, this isn't an OkFQHR requirement, but a requirement of the Expo Center, with whom your club has signed a contract that states this as one of the requirements for use of the facility. If you want to be able to keep utilizing this facility for our shows, we have to play by the rules.

We apologize for the costs involved, but we are only passing on what the Expo Center charges us, and we have no control over what the Expo Center charges.

**Attention All Cutters.....****If You Want Fresh Cattle, Let Us Know You Are Coming.....**

**In an effort to provide enough fresh cattle for the cutting classes without the wasted expense of over-ordering, there will be a pre-entry form sent to everyone who has previously entered the cutting classes. Please make every effort to fill these out and return them ASAP. Online entering is also available and is very user friendly. Those who return these pre-entry forms will have first use of the fresh cattle. Help us to help you!**

Do you have a 2005 foal that is eligible to show in the OkFQHR Futurity Stakes classes this fall?

PLEASE register these foals ASAP! Remember, if you send in your paperwork to AQHA via "snail mail", you can expect to wait a month or two to receive your papers from AQHA *before* sending them to FQHR for further processing.

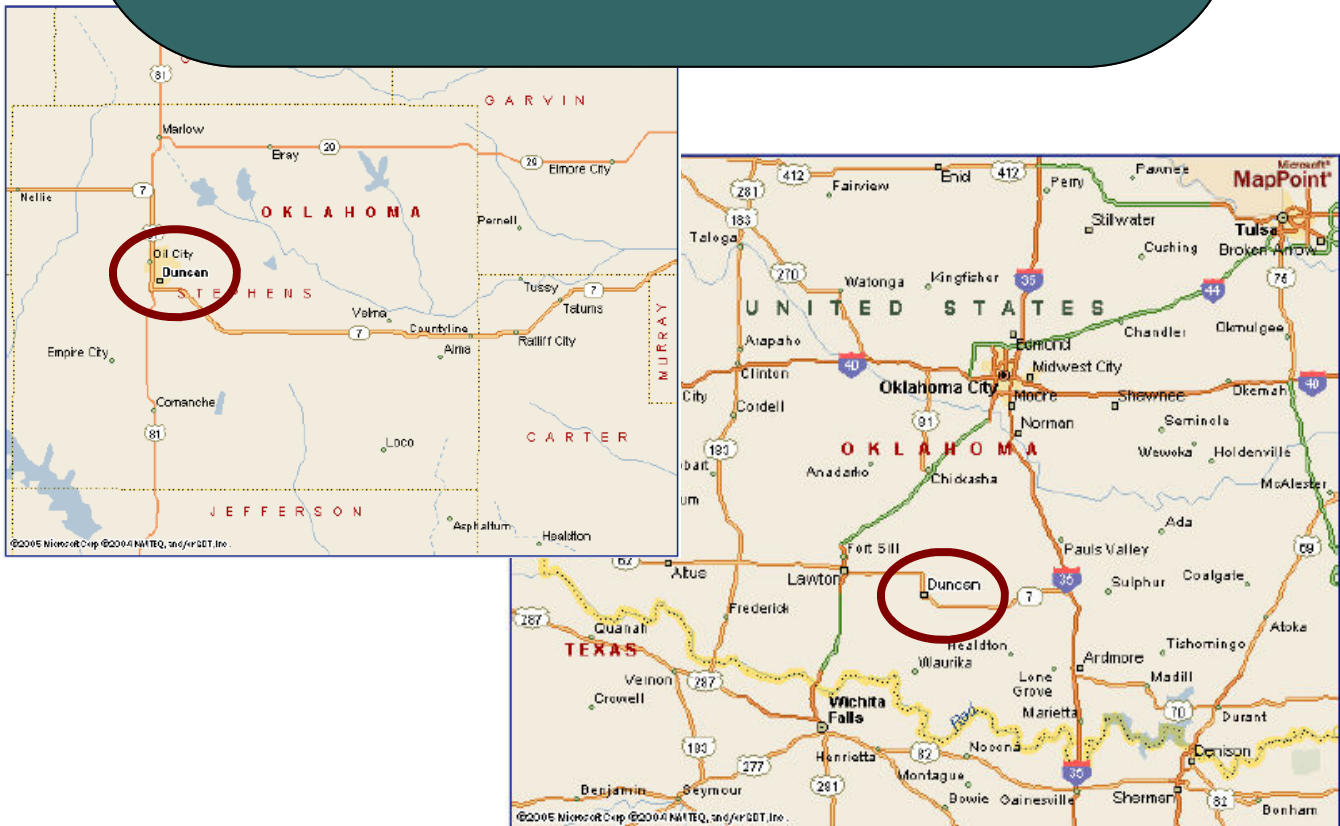
Directions

If coming from the north - go south through Duncan on Hwy 81.

The last stop light on the south end of Duncan is Bois D Arc Street—continue south through this stoplight and look for Haliburton on the left (or east side of road)

Just past Haliburton turn left and you should be facing the fair-grounds.

## Oklahoma Coggins (EIA Testing) Law

There has been some misunderstanding at previous shows about what is required for Coggins paperwork. The first thing that everyone needs to know is that this is an **Oklahoma State Law**, not just an OKFQHR requirement. And as an Oklahoma State Law, our show officials are required to enforce it or they can be held accountable.

We have researched the state statutes and called the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture for clarification. We won't bore you with legalese but if you want to look up the statute yourself, you can find it at:

**Here is what you need to know to show at OKFQHR shows (or any show in the state for that matter):**

- 1. All horses on the premises must be accompanied by an official record of a negative Coggins test within the previous 12 months.** This means if you have a horse at the show grounds that you are not showing, you still must have a record of a negative Coggins.
- 2. The only acceptable official test record is the “yellow paper” copy that you receive from the lab.** Photocopies of the “yellow paper” are not allowed.

Please make sure your Coggins paperwork is current and that you have your “yellow paper” with you for every horse when you arrive at the show grounds. Following this state law helps keep all our horses safe.

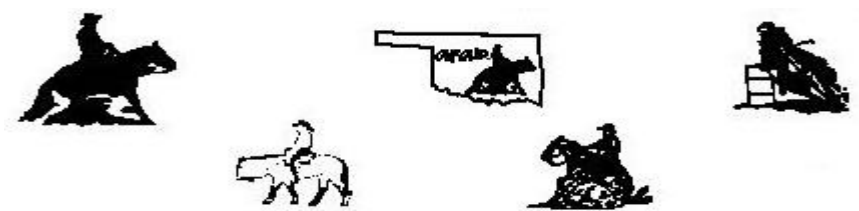
